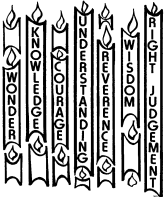

PENTECOST SUNDAY completes our fifty days of celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus. This Monday, we return to Ordinary Time and will continue until we begin again the Advent-Christmas Season in December. **If Christmas celebrates the birthday of Jesus, Pentecost celebrates the birthday of the Body of**



Christ, that we call the Church. Church literally means the "gathered ones." Church is not primarily a building. It is the "gathering of those who believe in Jesus." Shortly, after Jesus kicked off his public ministry, he started to gather around him a community of disciples. Then he deliberately and intentionally founded a Church. "Peter, you are the rock on which I will build my Church." Then he promised to be with the community of believers until the end of time. The Church, like Jesus, her founder, is both human & divine. Unlike Jesus, the Church is imperfect in her humanity because she is made up of sinners. Because of this, she is always in need of renewal. However, because she is divine, she is never in need of replacement. Just as Jesus was conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit, so was the Church conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit. On Pentecost Sunday, the Holy Spirit hovered over the disciples gathered in the Upper Room. Filled with the Spirit of God the newborn Church went off to fulfill the Mission of Jesus to "go forth, teach and baptize in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit." **The newly birthed Church was now the visible, tangible, presence of Jesus in the world.**
